Sub : Engagement of Senior Research Fellows on assignment basis at NTPC Power Management Institute (PMI), Noida

To thrive in today's world, which is witnessing rapid changes in both technology and the business environment, it becomes necessary to conduct research on critical issues. PMI being the premier learning institution of NTPC, also engages in research in order to create new knowledge to support the company. In this context, the Institute runs a Senior Research Fellowship programme. Under this programme about 4-5 research scholars are proposed to be taken for the year 2018-19. The work by the Senior Fellows is supposed to create new knowledge for NTPC in the chosen area of research.

Terms and Conditions of the Fellowship Programme

The Senior Fellows will undertake research on critical issues related to power/energy sector. While specific topics / themes will be provided later by NTPC, they would generally be in the areas of commercial and regulatory issues, new & emerging business areas for NTPC (e-mobility, desalination, power distribution), Operation & Maintenance of power plants, water management, new / emerging trends in Human Resource Management, big data and analytics, engineering and design, social impact of business, project management and finance etc.



The programme will be of one-year duration with provision for further extension upto six months on recommendation of the Evaluation Committee. Minimum qualification for Senior Fellows would be postgraduate with consistently high level of academic performance and flair for research.

The Senior Fellows would be paid consolidated stipend of Rs 60,000/- per month (to be paid in 2 parts i.e. Rs 40,000/- on monthly basis and balance payment of Rs 20,000/- after successful completion of work for the total period.). The Fellows will also be provided single seated/family residential accommodation as available with PMI. A contingency amount of Rs 60,000/- is also considered for meeting expenses on books/membership of sites/typing/printing etc.

Application and Selection

Interested and eligible candidates are required to send (i) CV giving details of academic performance, projects, work-ex if any, publications if any, contact details etc and (ii) a research proposal clearly indicating their area(s) of interest (on top of the proposal) choosing from the broad areas mentioned in this communication above (candidate can choose more than one area of interest, or can even suggest a new area related to NTPC/power sector but should justify/give details of each choice in the proposal). Proposal should not be more than 2000 words. The CV and proposal should be sent by email to seniorfellowntpc@gmail.com. Based on the evaluation of the CV, the research proposal and background of applicant, shortlisted candidates will be invited for an interview after which final selection will be done. The selection will be done on rolling basis till suitable candidates/fellows are selected. Candidates may start applying with immediate effect. Maximum upto 5 candidates will be selected. The applications will be accepted immediately after sending/date of this notice till all required/suitable fellows are selected. First shortlisting will be done after 30.07.2018. Shortlisted candidates of the first phase are expected to be contacted by email/phone normally by 13.08.2018.

PMI reserves the right to select/reject any candidate based on its judgment and no correspondence shall be entertained in this regard. Also it must be noted that it is purely short term academic engagement on assignment basis and does not have obligation on NTPC for employment in any form.
